Sunday – 3/3

11:30 a.m. Playground: HM goes straight to In the sandbox, HM grabs a shovel and starts digging. She smiles and throws the sand up in the air.

Sunday 3/10

10:20 a.m. – Book corner: HM Heavyn browsed through books for about 10 minutes. Throughout the book, she identified and named many things, such as "bird...baby...toy."

11:30 a.m. Playground: Bike riding- HM says “bike” runs to it and uses her feet instead of pedals to ride.

12:20 p.m. Snack time: Caregiver was holding a cup and asked HM to say cup? HM says “hup” Caregiver asked where certain body parts were. HM said “dis my nose, dis my mouth”.

Sunday 3/17

10:00 a.m. Arrival: HM arrives at center and cries for her Mommy not to leave.

10:20 a.m. Book Corner: HM rubs her eyes while drinking milk. She holds the carton with both hands. Caregiver asked if she was sleepy and she nodded her head yes.

11:40 a.m. – Nap time: HM goes to her cubby to get her “blankie.” She rubs her eyes, and comes to sit on my lap. She watches others as they listen to a bible story, lays her head against my shoulder. I asked HM, “Are you ready to nap?” She nodded her head yes. HM falls asleep quickly and slept until 12:50.

Sunday 3/24

11:00 a.m. Learning Area: HM was asked to repeat after the caregiver counting numbers. She then placed 3 different color blocks on the table for HM to look out. HM accurately recited the numbers she heard and successfully arrange items in the same order as shown.

12:15 p.m. Dramatic Area: AS was playing at the dramatic area. HM grabbed the toy plate and said "mine." HM cried when told it was AS time to play with it. She pointed at AS and said "no" "mine." Caregiver spoke calmly and redirected HM to another toy from the dramatic area.

1:05 p.m. Departure: HM smiles and runs towards Auntie Bev who was signing her out for the day.

Sunday 3/31

10:05 a.m. Arrival: HM comes to me smiling and allows me to hug her. I asked her if she was ready to play and have fun she nodded her head. I asked her to repeat saying yes, and she said "ye.ah"

11:20 a.m. Book Corner: HM says "mommy book". I asked HM if her Mommy reads books to her and she said "yeah." One of the caregivers told me that HM's mothers actually donated that book to the class.

12:30 p.m. HM played with CH and AS in the block area and stacked blocks as high as they could. When the blocks fell HM said "whoa." With her eyes stretched really big!
